PRIMARY OBJECTIVES

- In consultation with the YPM implement a program which facilitates excellence in team and individual preparation and performance in the Cricket Australia National Under 19 Championships and any other competition organised by Cricket NSW
- Preparation of players for selection in the NSW Under 19 program
- Ensure continuity between levels for elite male players.

1. NSW Men's Under 19 Coach

- Develop and implement a training and competition preparation program with YPM for the Cricket Australia National Under 19 Championships
- Attend scheduled training sessions, competitions and camps
- Engage specialist coaches where required in consultation with YPM
- Provide monthly reports to YPM on player development, training and match performances
- Attend U19s Country Championships, City Trials and City vs Country matches as Under 19 Youth Coach and selector
- Liaise with YPM and the Strength and Conditioning staff on program requirements; education, injury
- Reporting and treatment requirements
- Liaise with YPM regarding provision of services (where required) including:
 - sports psychology
 - team building
 - personal development (career, education, financial etc).
- Maintain season data and assist with match, player and opposition analysis utilising technology such as:
 - Sportscode and or
 - Silicon Coach
 - AMS
- Liaise with YPM on all matters concerning venues, equipment, uniforms and matches
- Communicate with grade club and regional coaches where required
- Conduct regular scheduled meetings with YPM
- Attend a number of Emerging Blues (regional) sessions as organised with the YPM
- Attend the Coaches Conference or any other conference that the YPM recommend
- Abide by and actively enforce Cricket Australia and Cricket NSW policies
- Submit a written report to YPM on all activities within 4 weeks of the conclusion of the Cricket Australia
- National Under 19 Championships competition
- Provide player reports for each member of the NSW U/19 squad on their performance during the season and/or the National Championships
